Year 11 Mock Results Day

As you know, your son/daughter recently completed their mock examinations. These examinations are a very important part of their preparation for the final GCSE examinations in the summer and therefore we try to make them as realistic as possible.

I would like to draw your attention to 'Mock Results Day' which is on Friday 7th January, 2015. We have run Mock Results Day for the last 3 years and it has proved to be very successful. Essentially we once again try to make this as much like the 'real thing' as we can. Therefore on the morning of 7th January students will attend registration as normal but then be asked to make their way to the school theatre where they will sign for their exam results – in the same way as they would for the final GCSE examination results. Teachers have used the mock results and students' performance in their controlled assessments (coursework) – where appropriate – to determine the most accurate current achievement grade. This will give students a clear indication as to their likely achievement in the final examination. As with the 'real thing', there will be a photographer on site to record the occasion and there will be staff available to provide support for students considering their next stage of education.
