Dear Parent/Carer

We are writing to let you know the arrangements for Year 11 after half term. Up until now we have kept all Year 11 in school studying as we feel that has been the most beneficial way of them studying and receiving revision tips. However, we appreciate that after half term there will be many lessons that students will have completed exams in and therefore we will allow students to study at home in-between their exams. As a result of this, your son/daughter will be allowed to start their study leave on Friday, 8th June.
