For GCSE Physical Education f/c and s/c, the following arrangements have been confirmed for summer 2022:

Non-exam assessment adaptations

GCSE physical education

- Permit exam boards to reduce requirement to 2 activities and allow both to be either 2 individual activities, 2 team activities or a combination of both team and individual activities.
- Permit remote moderation using videoed evidence for all activities.
- Permit exam boards to explore relaxation of the requirements for provision of evidence for example, type and quality of videoed evidence and the evidence of participation in competitive sport.

GCSE physical education (short course)

- Permit exam boards to reduce requirement to 1 individual activity or one team activity.
- Permit remote moderation using videoed evidence for all activities.
- Permit exam boards to explore relaxation of the requirements for provision of evidence for example, type and quality of videoed evidence and the evidence of participation in competitive sport.

Advance information

To make exams in 2022 less daunting, students will be told in advance some of the topic areas that will be included on the exam papers, helping them to manage their exam preparation. This information will be issued in the spring term to help students to focus their revision time.





However, the DfE have confirmed that if the impact of the pandemic worsens, this could be issued earlier in the academic year. We will update you on the timing of the advance information release once this has been confirmed.
