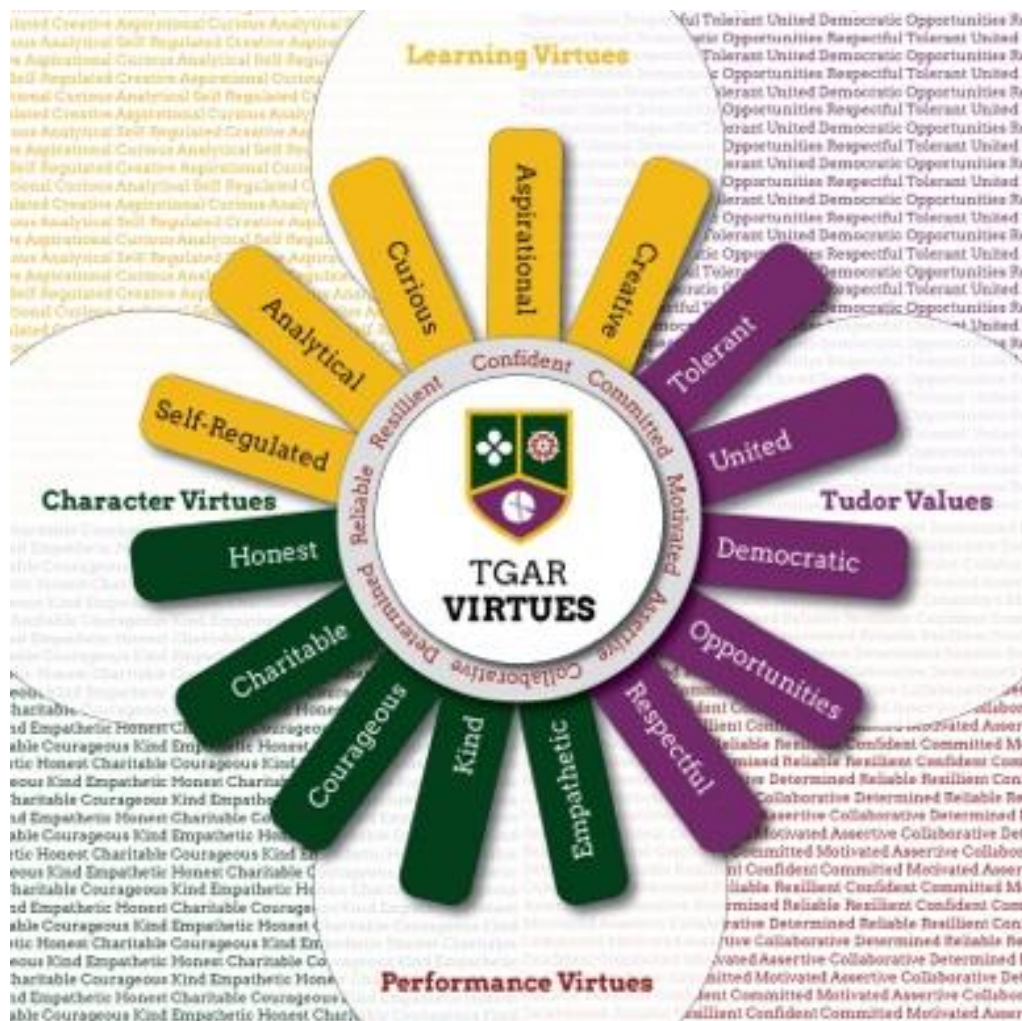


Tutor Time and PSHE

All students commence the day with a 20 minute tutor time. The structured tutorial programme reflects our emphasis on Tudor Habits and Values and students receive regular assembly slots.

In addition, students take part in 20 minute Reading programme to develop academic literacy. In 2024 we also began fortnightly Lyfta sessions in tutor time where students watch videos and engage in discussions to widen their understanding of the world.

We believe that 'character build success' and our TUDOR values of tolerance, unity, democracy, opportunity and respect underpin everything we do. Our TGAR virtues encompass the TUDOR values and help support students to develop the character traits that will help students flourish in life. These are taught through tutor time, PSHE, the curriculum and through extra-curricular entitlements.

- A Levels are allocated 8 hours fortnight with additional time per subject being set as independent study hours

Level 2 courses on offer at Post 16:

Students can retake GCSE English (3 hours a week) and Maths (4 hours a week) alongside One other subject at Level 2.



Sixth Form Enrichment

The Sixth Form Enrichment Programme at TGAR forms a core part of the Sixth Form curriculum. Enrichment takes place throughout the week and participation is compulsory.

Students are expected to attend 3 additional hours' enrichment in addition to their academic timetable, but they are encouraged to do more.

The programme provides a range of activities designed to:

- Extend students education and personal growth beyond the academic side of school life and to help to prepare them for their next steps
- Enable students to develop their personal, sporting, and social interests.
- Help support students' career aspirations by gaining relevant experience.
- Help students realise their potential and develop new interests.
